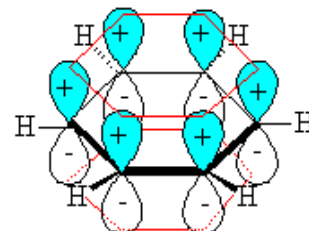


Survive Organic Chemistry(CHM 2210)...By following these 10 Easy Steps

- 1. DO NOT SKIP CLASS.** You will never be able to make up for lost lecture time. Active listening in class is the key.
- 2. Manage your time.** Set aside a specific time each day to do homework and study what was covered in class that day. There are SARC tutors in the lab everyday at a specific time do you homework and study here!
- 3. Make review sheets!** Go over your notes each day and make a sheet with some key points of the day's notes. Spend 10 minutes each day reviewing your notes and you will be prepared for the upcoming quiz or exam.
- 4. Read BEFORE you come to class.** It will make much more sense to you in class if you have seen the material before, even if you did not understand it when you read it the first time.
- 5. Do the problems within the chapters.** Workout sample problems in the chapter as you read. The answers are worked out for you. If there is a step you do not understand, mark it and ask for help.
- 6. Review your tests as soon as you get them back.** Organic Chemistry is cumulative. If you miss a question talk to your professor or a tutor to find out what you did wrong and fix it.
- 7. It is all in the name!** The great thing about Organic Chemistry is that many names, although very strange give you great clues.

- 8. Discover your personal memorization method.** If flash cards can not help you, do not use them. Also try to understand the concept instead of memorizing the concept. It is imperative you understand the concepts!
